Call for Recommendations

Advancement to the AIA College of Fellows is granted for significant achievement in design, preservation, education, literature and service. Election to fellowship not only recognizes the achievements of the architect as an individual, but also honors before the public and the profession an architect who has made a significant contribution to architecture and society on a national level. It presents the opportunity for broader participation in the public dialogue and for mentoring within the profession.

In order to be considered for fellowship, an architect must have been a member in good standing of the AIA for at least ten years. Submissions from the chapter are nominated by the AIA New York Chapter's Fellows Committee; candidates will then submit portfolios to the National AIA Fellows Jury in October.

The chapter committee is now accepting recommendations for those who will be nominated to fellowship from our chapter. If you would like to propose any eligible member, including yourself, for consideration by the Chapter's Fellows Committee, please send the candidate's resume and 10 photographs or other applicable documentation of the candidate's work to Fellows Committee, AIA New York Chapter, 536 LaGuardia Place, New York, NY 10012. All information must be received by **Thursday, April 19, 2007**.

The Committee will review the recommendations, select nominees and then work with those nominated to prepare binders for submission. Samples of successful binders are available at the chapter to those who would like to review them.
