



The Center for Architecture Grants and Scholarships for 2008

Stewardson Keefe LeBrun Travel Grants

Purpose

To encourage travel within North America and overseas in furtherance of the architectural education and professional development of the recipients.

Awards

Grant(s) of up to \$20,000 will be awarded. The amount of the individual award(s), based upon the applicants travel program, is at the discretion of the jury.

Eligibility

Applicants must be a U.S. citizen with a degree in architecture, a full time practitioner, either licensed or unlicensed. At least one award will be given to an architectural graduate who received their first professional degree at least five years prior to the date of submission.

Submission Requirements

Submit twelve copies of the following:

- A cover page with full contact information and a 50 word abstract of proposed travel plans
- A resume. Include name, address, telephone, email, academic background, degree in architecture and date, and a brief outline of professional experience with role in projects and/or firm. Please do not submit a portfolio or examples of work.
- A statement of purpose of approximately 500 words, outlining travel plans and explaining the value of the travel and its significance to the applicant's professional development. Supporting documentation, preferably not exceeding five pages, may be submitted at the applicant's option.
- Three letters of recommendation in support of the purpose of the travel and attesting to the applicant's capability and professional promise. One letter must be from an AIA member.
- A \$45 entry fee paid payable to the Center for Architecture Foundation
